**Acaena Inermis 'Purpurea'** (AKA in New Zealand as "bidibid") purple, 2" high – 8" pan, July. Purple leaves that are ferny-cut, soft, matting foliage. EVERGREEN! Walk on, run on, drive on, just get it on! Round flower heads. Excellent and outstanding groundcover, border plant, crevices, between pavers, walls, rocks, anywhere you want it! Sun, part-shade, average to dry soils, drained, drought, hard to do. Hardy to UUSDAZone 5. Philadelphia is zone 6 or 7 so plenty warm enough.

**Epimedium versicolor "Sulfureum"** (shade to part shade) Yellow flowers, 12-15", May-June. A vigorous form and probably the best that tolerates conditions others may not. Often chosen as the solution to the barren area where other plants perish.

**Fern "Ghost"** Silver-white Fronds 24-36" tall , give the entire plant a "ghostly" appearance. Prefers more moisture than not, part-shade to heavy shade. Forms patches up to 24" wide making useful as a ground cover if needed. Zones 4-8.

**Grass albula Carex "Frosted Curls"** The narrow light green with silvery-green highlights, almost iridescent weeping foliage, goes cascading over a container's edge. The compact clumping sedge (tufts to 20" wide 12-15" tall) lends softness and substance to a walkway's edge. Does nicely in the shade, while preferring moist - even wet – soils. Elegantly arching foliage creates a very symmetrical mound. Silver frosted tips gives this one great desire. From New Zealand originally. Zones 6-9.

**Hemerocallis "Happy Returns" Daylily** Lemon yellow flowers with green throat, 18-24", flowers from June-October. Most popular true yellow re-bloomer and on the evening garden list. This is the best repeat flowering daylily that we have ever seen. It far surpasses 'Stella' and has a much better color, a good clear yellow 3.5" flower on a 16" scape.

**Iris Cristata (shade to part shade)** Blue flowers , 6", May. Neat fans of small sword-like leaves. Flat, star-shaped flowers facing upward. Once established, preferably in semi-shade and moist soil, it will spread slowly until hindered. Excellent woodland or peat bank. Native to eastern US.

**Liatris "Floristan White" (Gayfeather, Blazing Star)** White spike (bottlebrushes) flowers 30" tall (commonly seen in purple varieties). Blooms July to September. Native to marshy places and damp meadows– hardy to zone 3 and grows best in full sun will tolerate some part shade. Attracts bees and butterflies

**Silene "virginica" common name is Fire Pink** Scarlet-red small multiple flowers, 22-24", April-May. 5 petal Flowers in large, loose, clusters. Long, narrow, dark green basal foliage. It is a Wildflower. Native. Pollinated by Hummingbirds.

**Tricyrtis h.MIYASAKI (Toad Lily)** 20-28", September-November. White orchid-like flowers are spotted lilac-purple. This is unique in that the stems arch sideways and the flowers appear all along the stems. Alternate green, pointed leaves are hairy on the edges.

**Uvularia Grandiflora (largeflower bellwort)** Flowers hang down and are light yellow, 18-24", April-May. Arching stems with pendulous flowers. The Flowers petals and the leaves have slight twist in habit. Native to NE US and Midwest. Hardy to Zone 3. Native habitat would be wooded slopes or in ravines.

**Hakonechloa macra 'Aureoia'**, grassy leaves are smooth narrow blades that are bright yellow striped forest green and acquire a tinted red-pink in the autumn. Foliage reaches to about 15-20" then arches exquisitely forming the unmatched effect this dramatic specimen is so prized for. Brought to us from Hakone in Honshu, Japan. Prefers partial shade – fertile well drained moist soil. 2009 Award winner. Hardy to zone 5. **\$12 EACH**

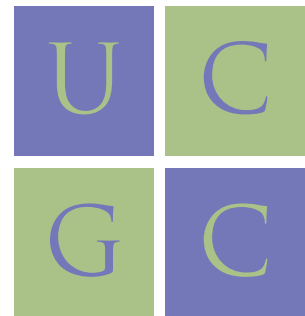
