x _____

yellow-greenish flowers, 18" June-July blooms. Clump-forming to 24". Pale green leaves with crinkled edges. Fine textured sprays of flowers. Silken leaves sparkle when rain or dew collects on them. DEEP SHADE to full sun.

Aquilegia COLUMBINE "Woodside mix"

x _____

Double white, rose, pink, plum, powder blue flowers 24" in April-May. English consider this the finest columbine available. Marbled lemon-yellow(cream) foliage some mottled, some not. Large, abundant 2 1/2" flowers. Sun or shade

Asclepias (butterfly weed, silkweed, milkweed, indian paintbrush) tuberosa

x _____

large heads of small bright orange flowers 24", July-Aug. Always a #1 choice to attract butterflies. Also used for cut flowers. Native to eastern North America.

Aster AKA Michaelmas Daisy, New England Aster (novae-angliae 'Purple Dome')

x _____

dark purple 18-24" Sept-Oct flowers. This newer cultivar stays naturally compact. Close flowers give a solid color effect. This selection was named by Mt. Cuba Center in Greenville, DE, originally from Mr. Robert Seip of Lennilea Farm in Alburtis, PA.

Baptisia (False Indigo) "screaming yellow"

26-32" May-June. This specimen will wake up the whole garden. Flower spikes are add'l 12" tall. Sun, light shade, you got to have it!! Native.

Coreopsis "sweet dreams"

x _____

white with raspberry eyes, 18-20" June to Sept. 1 1/2 in daisy flowers. Sun, light shade, average soil

Digitalis (foxglove) purpurea "foxy"

x _____

mixed, 32" June-July, Most popular, blooms first year. Sun, light shade, average drained soil.

Fern - "japanese painted"

x _____

Shade or semi-shade locations. athyrium nipponicum "pictum", the most colorful with soft grey-silver foliage with red and green flushes. Dark stems. spreads slowly to form a mound. 10".

Grass- andropogon scoparius "prairie blues"

x _____

grey-blue, medium size grass with ribbon-like leaf blades and late summer fluffy, silvery seed heads to 36-40". Hues of pink and red fall color. Native. SUN

Hemerocallis (Daylily) "hyperion"

x _____

A long lived perennial. Drought and heat tolerant. little to no maintenance. tolerates and grows well in practically any soil. Lemon-yellow flowers 38", 5" flower, FRAGRANT. July. Sun to part shade.

Lupine "Russell Hybrids"

x _____

mixed colors of red, pink, white, blue, yellow on stately spikes 30-36", May-June. Hybrid from George Russell of Yorkshire, England. Full sun and moist soil.

ice blue flowers 8-10", April-May, Fragrant. part-shade to deep shade tolerant. Hidden bargain.

lavender blue, 5-8" May-June. Different is what we have here. Mahogany tinged, small rounded leaves along a trailing stem give an incredible background fo the numerous open faced flowers. Sun to part shade. Prefers well drained soil

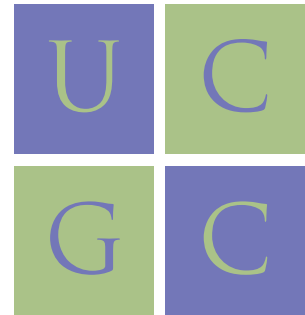
